Our 2022 Rosella's Pinot displays beautiful aromas of ripe plums and boysenberry. The palate is very rich and fullbodied, with ripe black cherry flavors accented by subtle baking spices ending with soft tannins and a long, silky finish.

Winemaking notes |

The first property planted to vine by the Franscioni family in 1996, it wraps around the family home and is named for Rosella, Gary's wife. Its rows of vines ascend from River Road up the hillside toward the mountain ridge, often laced with fog.
